Offering non-traditional hours, flexible scheduling and accommodating in-school and out-of-school youth, the Mon Valley Bridge is dedicated to providing support and real life tools for youth in foster care and those preparing to live independently who want to make an investment in their future.

A program of the Allegheny County Department of Human Services, the Mon Valley Bridge partners with locally-based groups dedicated to providing high quality programs for youth to achieve independent living. Mon Valley Bridge programs and services include:

Life Skills Training;
Job Readiness Training,
Employment preparation and Summer employment;
Technology training;
Housing Awareness & Assistance; Education (Financial aid & scholarship assistance and guidance,

College preparedness & campus tours, Assistance completing applications, Tutoring, and Linkage to GED & alternative education [Job Corps]); Mentoring; Healthy Relationships; and Linkage to other resources.

Each youth works with a coach to create a customized service plan to achieve his/her goals. Whether seeking a high school diploma, college or vocational training, or a job and place of their own, Mon Valley Bridge staff will help youth build a personalized plan.
